Rules and Guidelines Governing the

PSA Shooting Scholarship

Scholarship to be awarded to 1 applicant (up to \$1000) in each division(Archery, Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun) meeting the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Any Senior in High School may apply, providing he/she has been accepted to a two or four year university, college, or trade school. In the event an acceptance letter has not been received by the application date, proof of application to said school will be accepted provided the proof of acceptance is received prior to the release of scholarship funds.
- 2. Applicants must have participated: **per year for 2 years proceeding the year** in which the scholarship is awarded.

Archery: Attend 2 local and 2 state or national shoots

Rifle: Attend 2 local and 2 state or national shoots

Pistol: Attend 2 local and 2 state or national shoots

Shotgun: Attend 1 local shoot and 1 state shoot

3. Applicants must write an essay, in 750 words or less. "What has the sport of shooting meant to you and how do you plan on paying it forward"?

Interested candidates must file a completed scholarship application with PSA-Wendy Garrison to be postmarked, **no later than March 20**th **2024**. of the year in which the scholarship is awarded. Applications are available by downloading one off the club's website.

Items to be included with the application:

- 1. Acceptance letter (if acceptance letter has not been received see number 2 above).
- 2. Documentation of attendance at required shoots. (ex. Scorecards or copy of website with official results).
- 3. Typed Essay.

Selection of scholarship recipient(s) will be done at the May meeting of the scholarship committee. Recipient(s) will be notified after the meeting. Scholarships will be awarded at the June Club Meeting.

Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's chosen university, college, or trade school. Recipient is required to provide all necessary information to the PSA scholarship committee, to where the award is to be sent. This will include student identification number, and tuition billing address at said school.

Policy Governing the Scholarship

- 1. Your scholarship funds must be used for education purposes at any accredited university, college, or trade school.
- 2. Your scholarship is not contingent on grades. However, if for any reason you should leave school permanently, any remaining funds would revert back to the PSA scholarship funds. We must be promptly notified if this does occur.
- 3. Your scholarship fund must be utilized completely within one calendar year. Any funds remaining after this time period will revert back to the PSA scholarship fund. These funds will no longer be available to you, and there will be no extensions granted.
- 4. In the event that you receive other scholarship awards for tuition or other charges, you are to advise the PSA Scholarship Committee so we may consider payment of this award to you in such a manor as to assure the funds will be used in support of your educational pursuits
