## **Rules: Action Pistol Range (Pits)**

- 1. ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARM HANDLING while anyone is downrange.
- 2. Eye and Ear protection are mandatory for ANYONE in the pit, including spectators and children.
- 3. All firearms are to be cased or holstered (NO Cross Draw) when entering and leaving the range. If firearms are not cased, actions must be open and unloaded. No ammunition in the firearm(s).
- 4. The ONLY targets are the Club provided Steel Plates and Paper Targets.
- 5. All Firearm Discharges must be within the concrete walls.
- 6. Sharing a pit requires a common firing line.
- 7. Rules for Steel Plate Shooting:
  - A. Straight Wall pistol calibers only, NO Magnum calibers, .45 ACP max caliber.
  - B. Pistol Caliber Carbines are allowed only in .22LR, 9MM, .40, .45 ACP.
  - C. NO FULL AUTO ALLOWED
  - D. No Centerfire Rifle or Shotgun cartridges are allowed.
  - F. Must be at LEAST 21ft back from the steel when firing
- 8. For paper targets, all pistol calibers are permitted.
- 9. Prospective Member policy: See posted signs.
- 10. Violations of the range rules: MEMBERS WILL BE FINANCIALLY LIABLE for damages incurred.
- 11. This is your club, as a member you are part owner, maintain and police as your own.
- 12. All members and guests must display membership badge or guest pass

## Definitions:

Cold Range: All firearms must have open actions, unloaded, no ammo in chamber, magazine detached and step away from the firearm

Hot Range: All shooters are back behind the firing line and all shooters confirm they are ready to shoot.
